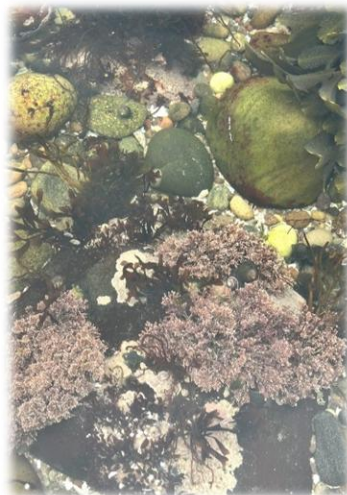
Wild Things Adventure Days

Seashore Explorer

An exciting day at the beach exploring the vibrant life within our rockpools, introducing you to the amazing creatures and seaweeds that thrive in this unique habitat.

Activities Include:

- Rockpool Exploration: Discover the diverse inhabitants of our rockpools.
- Seaweed Discovery: Learn about the interesting and useful seaweeds that grow along the shore.
- Seaweed Tasting: Taste test some of the seaweeds we can forage from along the coast.



Hidden Worlds - Delve into the hidden world of invertebrates. Perfect for nature enthusiasts of all ages, this event promises a day of discovery and fun!

Activities Include:

- Minibeast Hunt: Search for invertebrates in various woodland habitats.
- Camouflage Exploration: Learn how small animals camouflage themselves and practice camouflaging small objects in the woods.
- Kick Sampling: Explore what's hiding in the pebbles of a burn.
- Bug's-Eye View: Experience the woodland from a minibeast's perspective.
- Close Examination: Use magnifying glasses and ultraviolet torches to study our finds up close.



Hunter Gatherer – Craft & Foraging – A fascinating day where you'll discover what the forest meant to our Stone Age ancestors. This event will immerse you in the world of ancient survival skills and natural crafts.

Activities Include:

- Wildwood Crafts: Create practical objects using materials from the forest.
 - Foraging Skills: Learn to identify and gather plants that would have provided food, medicine, and other essentials 8,000 years ago.
 - Survival Insights: Understand how the forest served as a supermarket, clothes shop, pharmacy, and shelter for our ancestors.

River Explorer – Discover the world of Salmon & Otters- A Day by the water where you'll delve into the lives and habits of two iconic inhabitants of the River Findhorn: the otter and the salmon.

Activities Include:

- **Otter Exploration:** Learn about the habits and lifestyle of the playful otter.
- **Salmon Journey:** Discover the incredible life cycle and migration of the salmon.
- **River Habitat:** Understand the unique ecosystem of the River Findhorn and its inhabitants.



Woodland Treasure Hunt - A day following clues, tracks, riddles, games and challenges through the woods, discovering the dragon's treasure at the end.

Activities may include:

- Puzzle and riddle solving
- Discovering clues left behind
- Completing challenges



Special Halloween Adventure - A spooky day out in the woods with a cauldron of creepy creations, including Halloween masks, spider webs and more!

Activities may include:

- Mask making
- Spider web weaving
- Bat box building
