Hunter Gatherer Tracking

Tuesday 7th July

Could you have survived 8,000 years ago in the stone age forest? Learn the skills of a stone age hunter and tracker!

What you can expect:

- Make your own hazel bow and arrow to take home with you.
- Learn to move quietly though the forest, with fun games to put your sneaking skills to the test.
- Discover the tracks and signs that animals leave behind and how to follow them.



Hidden Worlds

Delve into the hidden world of invertebrates.

Perfect for nature enthusiasts of all ages, this event promises a day of discovery and fun!

What you can expect:

- Examine the hidden parts of the forest world, taking the perspective of its smaller inhabitants.
- Discover the hidden colours in nature using UV torches.
- Use a pond net and fish out the smaller creatures living in our streams that make the foundation of the food chains.



Animal Olympics

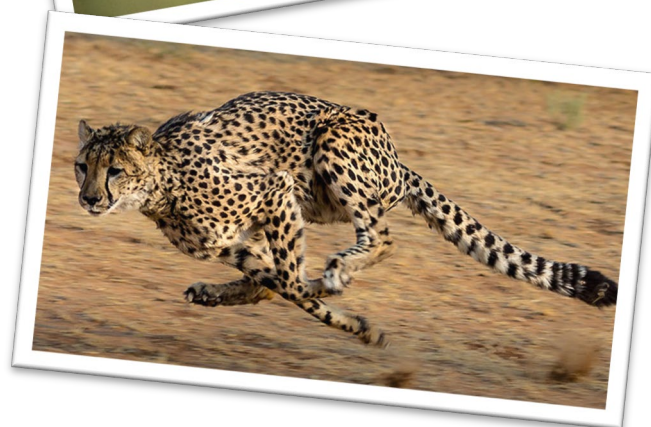
Tuesday 14th July

- Could you catch your food like a dolphin? Test your echolocation skills!



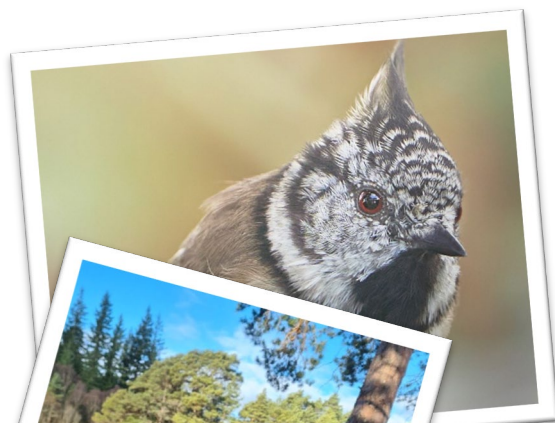
Day on the Wing
